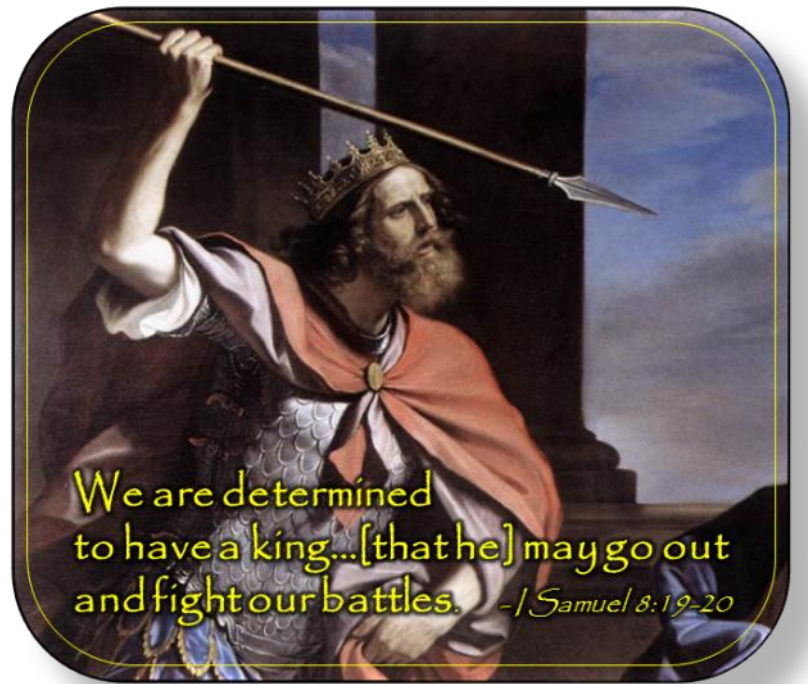

Leader: When the prophet Samuel grew old, and his sons revealed by their actions that they were not capable of continuing his leadership, the people of Israel cried out for a king.

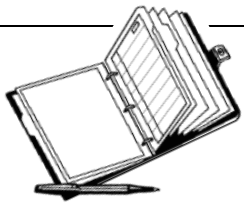
People: "Appoint for us a king, like other nations." (I Samuel 8:5)
